

REGARDING ACCESS

Dear Head Supervisor Langford,

I hope this email finds you well. I've discovered some new info regarding the Site-17 investigation (beyond Manafort's work on the same investigation). I've attached the site's construction orders over the last 12-ish months as well as the time clock records for the site's permanent staff.

The construction orders have been extensive. On paper, it's all renovations to the facility. However, staff timecards indicate that almost everyone is working full-time. According to the scale and frequency of the construction orders, the renovations being done should be shutting down large swaths of the site. If this were the case, then large portions of the staff shouldn't be able to work. I believe that one (or both) of two things is happening:

Site-17 is lying about the purpose of the construction orders. This would likely mean that they're building something in secret.

Site-17 is lying about their workers. This would likely mean that staff aren't showing up to work, but are being documented/paid as if they are.

I'm currently in the process of trying to get access to Site-17's HR records. Director Thomas Graham signs off on all of the construction orders, so I think his communications would be especially illuminating.

I'm writing this message to ask you for access to all of Graham's communications within Site-17. This would include emails and official memos, as well as any recorded phone calls. This would require temporary level 5 access.
