Jailbreaker is a safety initiative launched by Site-17 as part of its United Front concept. This initiative involves the re-training, re-arming, and re-structuring of the Site's security department. The initiative seeks to strengthen Site-17's security department by reinforcing the Site's current security detail with trained personnel from across the Foundation, who undergo a highly thorough and selective hiring process.

Criteria for Security Hires:

- Must have experience in handling firearms.
- Must be in the Foundation for more than 15 years.
- Must have no history in working for a Group-of-Interest.
- Must have no record of Foundation infractions in the last 10 years.
- An origin external to Site-17 is preferred.

Bailey was stationed in Area-14 as a member of MTF Nu-7 prior to joining the Site-17 security department.

Dawson was a senior security officer in Site-15 up until 2012, when she lost her senior position to another member of security after the Site underwent staff re-structuring.

Background:

Spurlock was a logistic specialist in the Office of Mobile Task Forces, whose responsibility was to delegate supply and equipment shipments to the various Armed Mobile Task Forces. In 2013, he was put out of the job when Mobile Task Force logistics and administration became outsourced to an external party.
