

INITIAL AUTOPSY NOTES (PERSONAL)

(Personal notes of Dr. Lindsey Koh, not intended for diagnostic use from other professionals)

Positive ID impossible due to condition of cadaver.

Director orders = assume ID unless proven otherwise. Security footage all but confirms (I have not seen). Dental examination should return positive (my+Graham opinion).

Aprox. 70% of skin on torso missing. Deep cavity stretching to spine/back of ribs.

Implements used to create entrance of various unidentifiable size.

Organ damage: Heart 90% present, intestines located mainly outside subject, deep lacerations on lungs, 20% of diaphragm located outside of cadaver

Director wants cadaver weighted. Unsure how to achieve due to state of subject.

Face is mostly gone.

Lacerations of trachea could suggest asphyxiation as CoD

Markings outside of torso suggest anomaly targeted non-lethal areas first.

Graham concurs, but claims subject's screams last less than minute on video

Asphyxiation most likely cause of death due to lungs, throat, and heart. Shock due to blood loss additionally likely.

Awaiting dental analysis, toxicology report (unlikely to find anything), and for techs to check body for differences in hume levels.
