A tragedy has befallen the Foundation.

As of earlier this week, Research and Containment Site-19 experienced what can be assumed as a CK-class Reality Restructuring event, causing it and the area surrounding it to vanish. This unfortunately means that not only have we lost Site-19, we have also lost the people in it, alongside the SCPs within.

Fortunately, it has been confirmed that Site-19 staff members and SCPs that were off-site at the time were not affected by this tragic event.

However, many were not as fortunate. The anguish that we feel over the loss of a facility cannot be overstated. More importantly, the grief we feel over the loss of our friends, our family members, and our colleagues is insurmountable.

Site-19 was the largest research and containment facility that the Foundation had in service. So I do not doubt that every person in the Foundation knew someone there. I do not doubt that every person here has lost someone.

This is a great loss. And my words only act as a disservice toward the otherwise indescribable sorrow we are all feeling.

As a show of solidarity, all non-essential staff will be granted 2-weeks of paid leave to grief.

Lastly, while I understand that it takes time to process these things, should any member of staff wish to speak to someone, the door to my office is always open.

May our friends and families in Site-19 be at peace, wherever it is they may have gone.
